It is equally important that your administration protect local businesses that do not fall within these parameters by allowing them to submit to the Small Business Administration's Office of Disaster Assistance a request for Economic Injury Disaster Loan assistance.

On Tuesday, March 17, 2020, as a part of the Trump Administration's aggressive efforts to combat the Coronavirus outbreak (COVID-19) and mitigate economic disruption to the nation's 30 million small businesses, U.S. Small Business Administration Administrator Jovita Carranza issued revised criteria for states or territories seeking an economic injury declaration related to COVID-19.

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

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
